



MNSA Indoor Saturday & Sunday Soccer 2011 Program Outline

The Marple Newtown Soccer Association (MNSA) Indoor Soccer provides an opportunity for area children to continue the fall soccer activity through the winter months. MNSA Indoor Soccer takes place during Saturday and Sunday from January through March. Each game is played in an indoor arena and will last for approximately 35 minutes.

Program Outline (divisions and game times are subject to change)

- The games will take place at the **Marple Sports Arena**, located at 611 South Park Way, Broomall, PA 19008.
- The program will be for 12 weeks. This includes week one for meet and greet / team practice, followed by eight weeks of games, two weeks of playoffs (Micro not included) and one week reserved.
- Divisions:
 - **Micro:** Boys and girls mixed. Six players plus a goalie.
U6 – Must be 5 by 8/1/10. 8/1/04 to 7/31/05
U7 – Must be 6 by 8/1/10. 8/1/03 to 7/31/04
 - **Novice:** Six players plus a goalie.
U8 – Must be 7 by 8/1/10. 8/1/02 to 7/31/03
U9 – Must be 8 by 8/1/10. 8/1/01 to 7/31/02
 - **Junior:** Six players plus a goalie.
U10 – Must be 9 by 8/1/10. 8/1/00 to 7/31/01
U11 – Must be 10 by 8/1/10. 8/1/99 to 7/31/00
U12 – Must be 11 by 8/1/10. 8/1/98 to 7/31/99
U13 – Must be 12 by 8/1/10. 8/1/97 to 7/31/98
 - **Senior:** Five players plus a goalie.
U14 – Must be 13 by 8/1/10. 8/1/96 to 7/31/97
U15 – Must be 14 by 8/1/10. 8/1/95 to 7/31/96
U16 – Must be 15 by 8/1/10. 8/1/94 to 7/31/95
U17 – Must be 16 by 8/1/10. 8/1/93 to 7/31/94
- Micro and Novice Divisions will play from 8 am to 10:30 am; Junior Divisions will play from 9:30 am to 12 noon; Senior Divisions will play 11:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- Players should wear their MNSA provided t-shirt for all games.

Equipment

- T-shirts (players to keep) provided by MNSA.
- An email will be issued to the coaches prior to the season explaining that the league will provide a t-shirt for the player to keep and remind players that shin guards are mandatory and soccer socks must cover shin guard. The email should remind parents to place the players name on all their equipment, such as water bottles, etc. The email will state that players must not wear jewelry and pants must not have zippers.
