4. Community Budget Recommendations

Mr. Driscoll explained this is the results of the Community Budget Committee \sim an update of what has been worked on over the summer \sim progress on activity

Mr. Mike Larkin presented the following:

- School Media, located in Minnesota
- Kid Friendly advertizing
- Ads change every 3 months
- 55 graphic ads
- We would have final say on ads

- Could earn up to \$50,000 per year
- Showed example of ad on locker
- Could be on tables, floors, walls, etc.
- Shared a fact sheet which was on back of presentation
- Any damage would be at their cost ~ there would be no cost to the district
- Different size wraps? Not sure but will check
- Could this be disruptive ~ concern Elementary and Middle School
- All installation done by the company
- Nothing on buses. They have done it, but this is not approved by PennDot
- Paid on a quarterly basis
- Has been done in our area ~ Pennsbury
- Can do some on our own ~ this would not interfere with the company, not inclusive
- Students have input on design? Probably not but can check into
- Brick program ~ paths and walkways ~ \$75.00 to \$95.00 per brick, will continue to research
- Athletic advertizing space ~ target money for future projects, example replacement of the turf
- Culinary Art Sponsorship
- Press Box Sponsorship
- Game Tickets ~ Custom on back of ticket ~ printed by Nuss printing would cost \$240.00. Advertising income would be \$1,000.00. This was approved
- Also have interested parties for advertising for Basketball, both girls and boys
- Using the Six Pillar's of Athletic ~ sponsor for each Pillar

Mr. Dricoll explained the Bus leasing/Buyback update

- There are 3 companies that handle this
- Traditional Lease rather than buyback
- Lease for 3 or 4 years
- On a buyback the cost included are repairs, inspections, tires, brakes, etc
- We repair seats, we don't clean, cheaper to have company to handle that
- The longer you have the bus, the cost of repairs increase, we only do small repairs
- Would have to increase staffing bur a few
- Don't have the funds to be able to start of own the buses
- Will continue refine and will continue to update the Board

- Act 1 index maybe 1.6%, will know more late September
- State Budget, overall not bad
- Accountability Block Grants did not go though

8. Furniture and Equipment – Capital Fund

Mr. Driscoll explained the following:

- TV Studio the largest expense, in house news cast fed by Student production ~ can be installed in house
- Funds coming from FF & E
- Bleachers, lower field need to be replaced, both baseball and softball, remove old ones; have bleachers for home and away teams. Bleachers presently do not meet regulations. Walkway needs railings
- Backstop, continue to solve problems, hitting homes, needs to be moved forward, trying to put cage inside what is presently there.
- Acoustical Shell, projects sound out, better sound, cost \$25,000. to \$35,000.
- There still would be \$300,000 in FF &E.

- Still work in TV Studio, would need to move equipment to be able to hold a class in the future.
- Gauntlett Center ~ Huge amount of time spent on trying to get Archival storage organized. Need a system. Looking at warehouse, need to do more research
