 - 1.) Capital Project Presentation from Bonnett Associates Incorporated.

Mr. Bonnett gave a brief summary of the presentation that will be given by Mr. Medica.

Mr. Medica gave the following presentation:

- o Russell:
 - o HVAC replace the system with the exception of boilers
 - Replace water filter system
 - Plumping to be replaced
 - Upgrade lighting to LED
 - Generators were replaced in the last 10 years

- Roofing has had some attention now out of warranty
- Addition for drop off
- Proposed gym
- Main office expansion
- Future classrooms
- Expand kitchen
- Under Act 34

Mr. Gallagher explained that the tanks for the fuel are on their last legs. While it is not a safety issue, it may be causing some damage to the busses with water getting into the tanks which has become an issue that we are continuing to monitor.

Provide six additional plantings adjacent to easement area. Costs for work are in accordance with John S. McManus, Inc. proposal dated 10/23/2020 in the amount of \$2,316.00.

COR 056 Ceiling Tile Replacement

John S. McManus, Inc. to replace ceiling tiles that were damaged during construction. Cost for work are in accordance with John S. McManus, Inc. proposal dated 1/7/2021 in the amount of \$3,427.00.

COR 057.1 Kitchen Sanitary Repair

John S. McManus, Inc. was directed to connect the existing kitchen sanitary into the new sanitary lateral on the west side of the building in accordance with drawing P000.1 issued by Bonnett Associates, Inc. as a result of problems with existing sanitary line that could not be cleared. Costs for work including excavation, fencing removal and reinstallation, new pipe work and asphalt repairs are in accordance with John S. McManus, Inc. proposal dated 7/23/2021 in the amount of \$52,011.75.

 - Roll out the "Here Comes the Bus" application no later than October 2, 2021.

Here Comes the Bus is an easy-to-use website and application that enables you to see the location of your child's school bus on a smartphone, tablet, or personal computer. This way, you know when the bus is near your stop, so you can send your child out to catch the bus at just the right time. Here Comes the Bus uses global positioning system (GPS) technology to locate and track your child's school bus. The application also uses HTTPS, just like a bank or online store, meaning all communications between your web browser and the site is encrypted and secure. Additional information about this application will be communicated to families prior to October 1, 2021.

- As of September 8, 2021, we are bussing students to 117 different schools, public and non-public.
- On any given school day, we are bussing approximately 5,480 children and utilizing 93 transportation vehicles.
