# District Goals 2019-2020

#### **Communications & Safety**

- To improve district-wide communications by implementing the CrisisGo App across the district in the event of a crisis
- To upgrade and increase radio communications across the district
- To hire two School Resource Officers under the direction of the Director of Safety
- To apply for two grants available through the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency to purchase security-related equipment and technology and to provide professional development for a school-wide positive behavior plan at the middle school

## **Student Safety and Well-being**

- To foster Trauma Sensitive Classrooms and Schools through partnerships with Cabrini University and the DCIU (3 year process)
- To train designated elementary staff to serve on their school's Student Assistance Program (SAP team)
- To institute a universal screening tool for second grade students for academic purposes
- To involve Russell Elementary staff in an effective school climate improvement process in partnership with the DCIU (who is piloting this new approach)
- To create a College and Career Access Center along with School Counseling at the high school by realigning the counseling department's responsibilities
- Special education teachers (K-12) will receive training to properly collect behavioral information, complete required forms and analyze the data to inform educational and behavioral practices of our students.

#### **Student Achievement**

- To provide professional development for special education teachers (6-12) and content area teachers (6-12) who co-teach a class in integrated teaching through a partnership with the DCIU
- To continue with the district initiatives of Before, During and After (B-D-A) Lesson Planning and Total Participation Techniques (TPT)
- To develop protocols for data meetings between administrators and teachers for the purpose of guiding instruction

## Facilities

- To complete a feasibility study at Paxon Hollow Middle School and Worrall Elementary School during the 2019-2020 school year
- To complete both construction projects at Culbertson Elementary School and Loomis Elementary School on time
